



Potomac Odyssey Relay - Additional Information

We are thrilled that you are joining us on April 27th for the Potomac Odyssey Relay! As you are probably aware, you will be running the last quarter of the American Odyssey Relay. So, you will be picking up the American Odyssey at leg 28, which is Potomac Odyssey Relay leg 1. Other than different leg numbers, everything else is the same between the last 9 legs of the American Odyssey and the Potomac Odyssey Relays. Following are some specifics (in addition to those already on the Potomac Odyssey Relay site under Individual Leg Maps [here](#).)

1. You do not need to attend the team captains' meeting in Gettysburg the night before the American Odyssey, but please be at the start of the Potomac Odyssey no later than 6:30 AM on the April 27th.
2. The start is at 100 S. Maple Ave., Brunswick, MD, which is transition 27 of the American Odyssey Relay (start of leg 28.) It's the Brunswick Marc Station.
3. We will bring race packets that will contain t-shirts, a slap band, van signs, race numbers, safety pins, etc. Please double check that the t-shirt sizes for all of your team members are correctly in the registration system, as we can't carry a ton of extras with us to the start. There will be limited trade-in options at the finish line, as long as supplies last.
4. There will be bathroom facilities available in close proximity to every transition except T7, which is the end of leg seven at Wilson Lane. There is a portable toilet about 1/4 mile away from there in the parking lot across the bridge.
5. If you think you will finish after 6:00 PM, please let us know.
6. Please follow all of the safety rules set out in the Potomac Odyssey Handbook and Safety Manifesto. We've created a handbook just for Potomac Odyssey Relay this year. You will be running entirely during daylight hours and most of your legs will be off-road, but there *are* three legs that require running on open roads, so please read and follow these rules!
7. There is a lot of other important info in the Handbook that relates to the Potomac Odyssey, such as EMT and other safety-related info. Please read it carefully!
8. Please review leg 9, the last leg of your race. If you have run with us in the past, this leg has changed slightly as the finish line is located at Maine and 7th. We will have signs out along the way. Team Captains have received detailed information.
